Dear Mr. Cove:

As you are aware, subsequent to your letter under date of July 5, 1996, a meeting was conducted between representatives of our two organizations' Executives. At that time, the MAA's representatives undertook to present certain recommendations to its Council.

I am now pleased to advise that the following motion was passed at the September 26, 1996 meeting of the MAA Council:

".....THAT the MAA re-confirm its recognition of ABTAM as the sole organization to certify architectural and building technologists in Manitoba. CARRIED"

In addition, the MAA Council agreed, in principle, to have a member of this Association's Council attend meetings of your organization's "MAA Liaison Committee", and will appoint such a member on an as needed basis.

For your information, we have attached a copy of a letter recently forwarded by the Committee of Canadian Architectural Councils to the Chair of the Committee on National Standards for Applied Science and Engineering Technologies and wish to emphasize that this letter represents the collective position of all ten architectural licensing bodies in Canada.
